You can also email your photos to photocontest@pressenter.com but a signed entry form must also be attached, or dropped off / mailed in separately by the contest deadline.
- ✓ All entrants must fill out an entry form, complete with signature of photo release. If the entry form is not signed, photos will not be accepted. Entry forms are available at the River Falls PressEnter! offices and at the Hudson Chamber of Commerce. You can also download the entry form at hudsonhotairaffair.com
- ✓ Be sure to carefully place your name and phone number on each disc.
