Each February, thousands gather across Hudson for launches, family activities, the torchlight parade, and the iconic Moon Glow at E.P. Rock Elementary.

Position Overview: Volunteer Coordinator

The Volunteer Coordinator is one of the key leaders within the HHAA planning team. Think of this role as the Rebel Alliance Commander for volunteers — organizing, guiding, and empowering our crew to keep the festival running smoothly.

This person is warm, organized, detail-driven, and loves bringing people together. No ballooning or Jedi training required — just a passion for community and coordination.

Key Responsibilities

- Recruit the Rebel Volunteers
 - o Connect with returning volunteers and recruit new helpers
 - o Coordinate outreach and volunteer promotions
 - o Manage volunteer sign-up platforms (Google Forms, SignUpGenius, etc.)
- Assign Missions & Build the Roster
 - o Match volunteers with roles that fit their strengths
 - o Build and share the festival weekend volunteer schedule
 - Work with committee chairs to fill priority roles
- Prepare the Crew for Launch
 - o Send pre-event communications and orientation details
 - o Create clear instructions and expectations for each role

- Event-Weekend Support (Feb 6–8)
 - Manage the volunteer check-in headquarters
 - o Ensure each volunteer has info, support, and supplies
 - o Troubleshoot needs and shift volunteers as required
- Post-Event Wrap-Up
 - Send volunteer appreciation communications
 - Collect feedback
 - o Help document strategies and improvements for next year

Qualifications

- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Able to use basic digital tools (email, spreadsheets, sign-up systems)
- Team-oriented, flexible, and calm under pressure
- Comfortable giving direction and supporting volunteers
- Available for planning meetings (1–2 per month) and present during festival weekend

Time Commitment

- December January: ~2–4 hours per week
- Event Weekend (Feb 6–8): Higher on-site involvement
- After Event: 1–2 hours of closing tasks

This role is fully volunteer and essential to the heart of HHAA.
